A guide to setting up and using MYOB Payroll



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Aim of this Book

The aim of this manual is to explain how MYOB software can be used to perform the payroll function. Stress is placed on the correct setup of your payroll parameters and in so doing ensures that the payroll operator can spot any irregularities in their payroll entries. It does not attempt to explain all of the rules relating to payroll. For example, I will not be stating which employees are entitled to holiday leave loading or provide a definition of “ordinary times earnings”. It is assumed that you, the user, will already know this or can glean it from other sources such as the ATO or your industry awards.
